RIDER SCHEDULE DPS-4**APPLICATION**

This Rider Schedule is applicable upon request to data pulse service necessary for the operation of Customer's load control equipment or for other purposes required for Customer's benefit or convenience.

BILLING

In accordance with the provisions of the applicable rate schedule used in conjunction herewith except that there shall be an additional charge of five and 35/100 dollars (\$5.35) added to the net monthly billing of such schedule before application of the rate schedule adjustments.

DATA PULSE SERVICE SUPPLIED

Data pulses shall be three-wire contact closures only and shall be meter pulse data only. Time pulses will not be furnished. In cases where Company is using pulse metering, Customer shall accept the value of these pulses for his use and shall make accommodations accordingly in the event Company finds it expedient to change the value of the pulse.

Company shall not be required to provide operating voltage to Customer's equipment. Customer's pulse circuit operating voltage shall not exceed nominal 120 volts AC or DC. The maximum load connected to Company's pulse devices shall be 0.075 KVA and Company's equipment shall be protected by fusing all pulse circuits provided for Customer's use with a fuse rated at a maximum of one ampere. Slow-blow fuses shall not be allowed and Company shall not be responsible for pulse interruptions due to blown fuses. The one ampere fuses shall be so located that the Customer shall have access to them when necessary. The circuits with one ampere fuses shall be backed up with two ampere fuses located inside Company's meter cabinet.

Any replacement of equipment or material for supplying pulses shall be at Customer's expense. Maintenance of Company equipment shall be performed by Company. Company shall not be responsible for more than ordinary care of said equipment and when said ordinary care has been exercised, shall not be liable to Customer for loss or damage occasioned by failure of said equipment.

Upon request of Customer, Company will make special tests of its equipment. If such test indicates a malfunction in Company's equipment, appropriate steps will be taken to remedy said malfunction. Should, however, such test indicate that Company's equipment is functioning normally, Customer shall bear the cost of the test, and the minimum charge therefore shall not be less than \$25.

INSTALLATION COST AND CONTRIBUTION IN AID OF CONSTRUCTION

Customer shall pay to Company prior to Company's making data pulse service available to Customer an amount equal to the total estimated installed cost of all necessary equipment to make such service available or an amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00), whichever is greater. This amount shall be a contribution in aid of construction and shall not entitle Customer to ownership of any data pulse service equipment installed.

CONTRACT PERIOD

In accordance with the contract term of the rate schedule used in conjunction herewith.

RESERVATION

Subject to orders of regulatory authorities having jurisdiction and to the provisions of Company's Service Policy on file with the Mississippi Public Service Commission.
